RIBBON-CUTTING CEREMONY FOR TWO NEW SAN DIEGO BLOOD BANK BLOODMOBILES

New Vehicles Expected to Impact Up To 27,000 Lives Each Year

WHAT: Ribbon cutting ceremony for two new San Diego Blood Bank bloodmobiles.

WHEN: Thursday, December 1, 2022, 8:00 a.m.

WHERE: San Diego County Operations Building, 5598 Overland Ave, San Diego, CA 92123

NOTES: These new bloodmobiles are expected to collect more than 27,000 donations annually. Since each bloodmobile's life span is approximately 15 years, these buses could potentially help save hundreds of thousands of lives in our community and beyond.
