SAN DIEGO BLOOD BANK CELEBRATES NATIONAL DONUT DAY

WHAT: The San Diego Blood Bank will return to its roots and serve donors donuts at four of their donor centers today in recognition of National Donut Day.

National Donut Day was established in 1938 to honor volunteers who made donuts for soldiers serving overseas during World War I in an effort to boost morale. National Donut Day is celebrated annually on the first Friday of June.

WHEN: Friday, June 7, 2019, 8 a.m. – 4 p.m.

To be eligible to donate blood, you must be at least 17 years old, weigh at least 114 pounds, and be in general good health.
